

GRADUATE CERTIFICATE DATES 2009

ELT501

- **Semester 1**
- Four days face-to-face (f2f), plus one follow up day
- **Launceston** - Tuesday Feb 3 - Friday February 6 (three weeks prior to the commencement of semester 1) and Thursday April 9 (1st day of Easter break)
- **Hobart** – Tuesday February 10 – Friday February 13 (two weeks prior to the commencement of semester 1) and Thursday April 9 (1st day of Easter break)

ELT502

- **Semester 2**
- Three days f2f, plus one follow up day
- **Launceston** – Monday June 22 –Wednesday June 24 (4th week of 6 week inter-semester break) and Friday September 4 (mid-semester break week)

ELT503

- **Spring school**
- Two days f2f, plus one follow up day
- **Hobart** - Monday November 30 – Tuesday December 1 and Monday February 1 (2010)

ELT504

- **Semester 1**
- One day f2f and subsequent meetings with unit coordinator individually negotiated
- **Launceston** - Friday February 13 (two weeks prior to the commencement of semester 1)

- **Semester 2**
- One day f2f and subsequent meetings with unit coordinator individually negotiated
- **Launceston** - Thursday June 25 (4th week of inter-semester break)

ELT505

- **Semester 2**
- Four days f2f (two in June and two in September)
- **Launceston** - Tuesday June 9 – Wednesday June 10 (2nd week of 6 week inter-semester break) and Monday August 31 – Tuesday Sep 1 (mid-semester break week).

CAM502

- **Semester 1**
This is the first unit of the Graduate Certificate in Learning and Teaching for Health Professionals. It will be offered for the first time in 2009. Given that the unit is designed for health professionals, delivery is likely to take the form of a series of short workshops, rather than block days. Location and times are yet to be confirmed and will be dependent upon numbers and location of participants. Final decisions regarding delivery will be made by the unit coordinator, Dr Craig Zimitat.

CAM506

- **Semester 2**
- Three days f2f, plus one follow up day
- **Launceston** – Monday June 22 –Wednesday June 24 (4th week of 6 week inter-semester break) and Friday September 4 (mid-semester break week)
